CAR ROLLED

PALMYRA TWP. — A Tecumseh man was hospitalized after he drove off U.S. 223 and rolled his car over into a field at about 4 p.m. Thursday. The one-car accident happened west of Palmyra near Carleton Road.

The driver, Ken Thompson, 28, of Tecumseh, was taken by Palmyra Township ambulance to Bixby Hospital, where he was admitted to the intensive care unit. He was listed in stable condition this morning.

Details of the accident were not available this morning from the Lenape County Sheriff's Department.

MOTORCYCLIST HURT

ADRIAN — An Ottawa Lake man crashed his motorcycle into the rear of a car that pulled in front of him on East Beecher Street east of Gulf Street, at 2:30 p.m. Thursday.

The motorcyclist, Randy Prisby, 31, of 2555 Sylvania-Petersburg Rd., Ottawa Lake, was transported to Bixby Hospital, where he was treated and released.

Adrian police reported Prisby crashed into the rear of car driven by David Lee Seegert, 44, of 9975 Forche Rd., Blissfield, when Seegert pulled into his path from a private driveway.

Seegert was charged with failure to yield.

CRASHES INTO TREE

SENECA TWP. — A 24-year-old Massena man was injured when he lost control of his car and

crashed into a large tree off Weston Road, just east of Yankee Road, early this morning.

Kevin Mark Hall, of 8098 W. Weston Rd., was treated and released from Morenci Hospital after the 4:25 a.m. accident.

Sheriff's deputies reported Hall was eastbound on Weston Road when his car went onto the berm as he was making a curve. He lost control in the loose gravel, the auto crossed the roadway and slammed into the tree.

He was charged with a violation of the basic speed law.

INTERSECTION CRASH

ADRIAN — Two Adrian women suffered minor injuries in a two-car collision at the intersection of South Winter and South Main streets at 4 p.m. Thursday.

According to Adrian police, Agnes O. Harper, 73, of 749 S. Winter St., drove into the intersection from Winter Street and was hit by an auto northbound on Main Street driven by Kristine Ann Miller, 18, of 3383 Valley Dr., Adrian.

Mrs. Harper and a passenger in the Miller auto, Sabrina Sampson, 18, of 1108 S. Main St., both sought their own treatment. Mrs. Harper was charged with failure to yield.

CASH MISSING

ADRIAN — An Adrian man reported someone entered his apartment and stole \$170 in cash and the title to his car.

Dono Bailey, of 266 Cross St., told Adrian police that the theft occurred Wednesday night or early Thursday morning.

Circuit Court

A one-year jail was handed down in Circuit Court to an Adrian man convicted on a child molesting charge. And a man Flint was convicted by a jury Thursday evening on charge of passing a bad check in Adrian.

Schmidt was accused of sexually molesting a girl in Raisin Township in June and July of 1982 and March, April and June of 1983. The girl was 6 and 7 years old when

the incidents occurred. He pleaded guilty to the single count of second degree criminal sexual conduct on Aug. 29. Three other second degree and one first degree counts were dismissed.

A jury deliberated two hours before returning a guilty verdict against Glenn Leason, 41, Flint, who was tried Thursday on a charge of uttering and publishing the name of Kenneth B. Glass, administrator, at 6 p.m.

Jeaso was charged with cashing a bad \$475 check at the Meijer Thrifty Acres store in Adrian on Sept. 17, 1983.

At a session of said Court held at the Judicial Building in the City of Adrian, in said County on the 4th day of October A.D. 1984

Present: Hon. JOHN C. TIMMS Circuit Judge

The defendant in this cause having been duly convicted of the crime of Second Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct as appears by the records and files thereof, and the Court believing that the defendant will profit by the leniency of the Court,

Therefore, the Court does order and adjudge that the said Defendant be and hereby is placed on probation under the charge and supervision of Gerald W. Judd as Senior Probation Agent or such other person as the Court may hereafter designate, and for the term of 5 years from and including the date of this order.

It is Further Ordered and Adjudged by the Court that said Defendant, during the probationary term herein fixed shall abide the following terms:

- FIRST: That he shall not during the term of his probation, violate any criminal law of the State of Michigan, or of any other State or of any ordinance of any municipality.
- SECOND: That he shall not during the term of his probation leave the State without the consent of this Court.
- THIRD: That he shall report to the Probation Agent, in writing and in person at a time set by the Probation Agent. He shall inform the Probation Agent, prior to any change of address or employment.
- FOURTH: That he shall absolutely refrain and desist from the use or possession in any manner of illegal drugs prohibited by the Controlled Substance Act.
- FIFTH: That he absolutely refrain and desist from the use in any manner of all intoxicating liquors, or furnishing liquors to others, and that he refrain from entering taverns, pool rooms, or other places where gaming tables are kept or run, or where any gaming devices are kept or operated in any manner whatsoever.
- SIXTH: That he shall not engage in any anti-social conduct which shall furnish good cause to this Court to believe that this probationary order should be revoked in the public interest.
- SEVENTH: That he spend the first 12 days/months in the Lenawee County Jail with credit for time served from/for 4 days.
- EIGHTH: That he shall be gainfully employed or enrolled in a school or training program approved by the probation agent.
- NINTH: That he pay into the County Clerk's Office COSTS of \$ 985.00 (including attorney fees of \$185.00). FINE of \$ also, RESTITUTION in the amount of \$. All amounts will be paid at the rate of \$ 10.00 per week, the first payment will be due third Monday after release from jail. Payments to the Court will be credited first to the Costs of the Court and then to any restitution ordered by the Court.
- TENTH: That he shall participate and cooperate in the Community Service Program as directed by the Probation Agent.
