This information will enable us to identify Mr. Olson should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program.

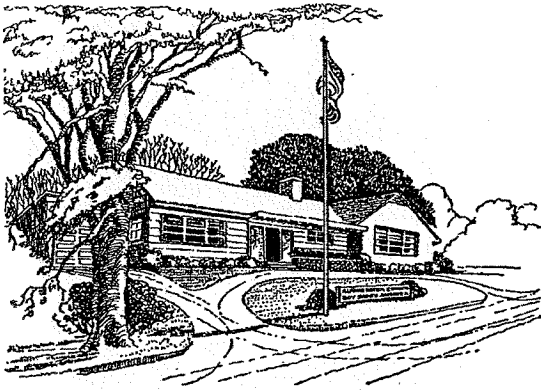
