Colesburg police chief charged with sexually abusing young boy

CQLESBURG, Iowa — Leavitt L. Bush, the 35-yearold police chief of this tiny Delaware County community, is jailed today on charges stemming from incldents in which he allegedly gave beer to a young Colesburg boy, sexually molested him and later threatened his own family with a gun.

The boy, who is believed to be about 13 years old, was not injured, according to Evert Klaus, mayor of this community of 390 persons about 35 miles northwest of Dubuque.

Delaware County sheriff's deputies who arrested Bush here Friday afternoon said three charges were filed against him stemming from the Wednesday incident involving the boy. They are: Sexual abuse, lascivious acts with a child and making beer available to a minor.

Two other charges of terrorism and going armed

with intent to commit a felony were filed against Buth as a result of an incident Friday la which invest tigating officers said he allegedly threatened members of his family with a gun. No family members were in fured.

Bush, who is married and has a family, was appointed police chief here last October, according to Mayor Klaus. The town's two other police officers, and deputies from the Delware County sheriff's office, will be handling law enforcement work in the community, said Klaus.

Bush appeared before Delaware County Magistrate Hope Toomer of Delhi Friday where bonds totaling \$25,100 were set on the five charges. Unable to post bond, Bush was taken to the Delaware County Jail at Manchester, where he is being held today awaiting a court hearing to be set later.
